# The structure of the Greek educational system

University

Lyceum (15 - 18)

Gymnasium (12 – 15)

Primary school (6-12)

Kindergarten (4 – 6)

Toddlers (2.5 - 4 years old)

#### Pre-school education

- Nursery schools → 2,5 to 4 years old optional
- ►Kindergarten Nipiagogia → 4 to 6 years old compulsory
  - ➤ 4 years old → pronipia
  - > 5 years old → megala nipia

## Primary education

- It lasts for six years and it is compulsory
- Children are admitted at the age of six & they are divided into six grades
- The subjects are:
- ✓ Language education (reading writing)
- Arithmetics
- ✓ History
- ✓ Geography
- ✓ Arts
- ✓ Religious education
- ✓ Physical education
- ✓ English

#### Secondary education

- Junior High School Gymnasium
- 12 to 15 years old
- Compulsory education
- More subjects are added to curriculum:
- ✓ Ancient Greek language
- √ Chemistry
- ✓ Biology
- ✓ Technology

### Secondary education

#### Senior High School - Lyceum

- ■15 to 18 years old
- Optional education
- ➤ General Lyceum → scientific subject
- ➤ Technical Vocational Lyceum EPAL → scientific and technological subject

## Tertiary education

■University → 4 to 6 years

Polytechnics → 5 years

■ Higher Technological Institutions → 4 years
